What is the point of a bridge?

A bridge makes it possible to go between two places that were previously difficult to cross. Bridges fill a gap, make a crossing point. Bridges connect people.

I have seen all of those five bridges at some point in my life but I've seen no greater bridge than Jesus.

On Easter Sunday we can picture Jesus as the greatest bridge in the world.

Remember we said 'bridges fill a gap'?

There was once a gap between God and us.

Adam & Eve had destroyed our bridge to God.

Ever since, humanity had been separated from God because of sin & selfishness.

We had cut ourselves off from God.

Many people still live life cut off from God.

But God has done something about it.

Because he loves us. He loves you.

God sent his only son Jesus to be a bridge. He is our go-between.

Jesus is the bridge.

Jesus is your bridge.



- He is your bridge from sin to forgiveness.
- He is your bridge from guilt to peace.
- Jesus is your bridge from captivity to freedom. Your bridge from defeat to victory!
- Your bridge from sorrow to happiness.
- Jesus is your bridge from selfish living to serving others.
