Receiving anew all you have accomplished for us in Jesus Christ,

We offer our sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving, Presenting these gifts which you have given.

We remember his death, We proclaim his resurrection, We await his coming in glory!

Send your Holy Spirit among us
And upon these gifts of bread and wine,
That the sharing of this bread may be
A participation in the body of the living Christ,
And the sharing of this cup a participation in his blood,

That we may serve you in unity, faithfulness and joy Until you bring us with all your saints into the fullness of your eternal kingdom; through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Through him, with him, in him, In the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honour is yours, Almighty God, for ever and ever. Amen.

Breaking of the Bread

The bread we break is a sharing in the body of Christ.

Christ is the Bread of Life.

The cup we take is a sharing in the blood of Christ. Christ is the true Vine.

We say together:

Lord, we come to this your table,
Trusting in your mercy
And not in any goodness of our own
We are not worthy even to gather up
the crumbs under your table,
but it is your nature always to have mercy,
and on that we depend.

So feed us with the body and blood of Jesus Christ, your Son, that we may forever live in him and he in us. Amen.
