

We come together

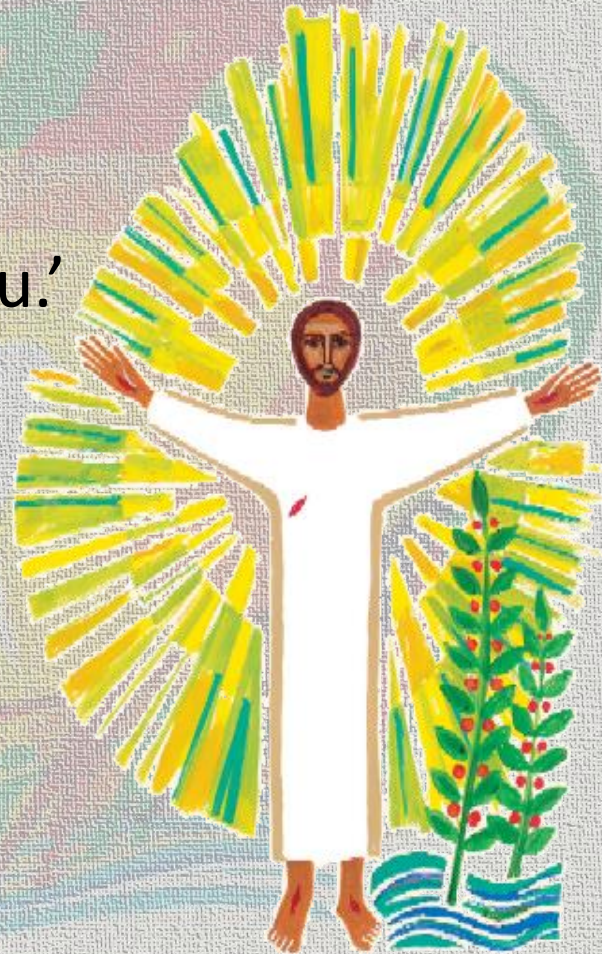
God's grace and peace

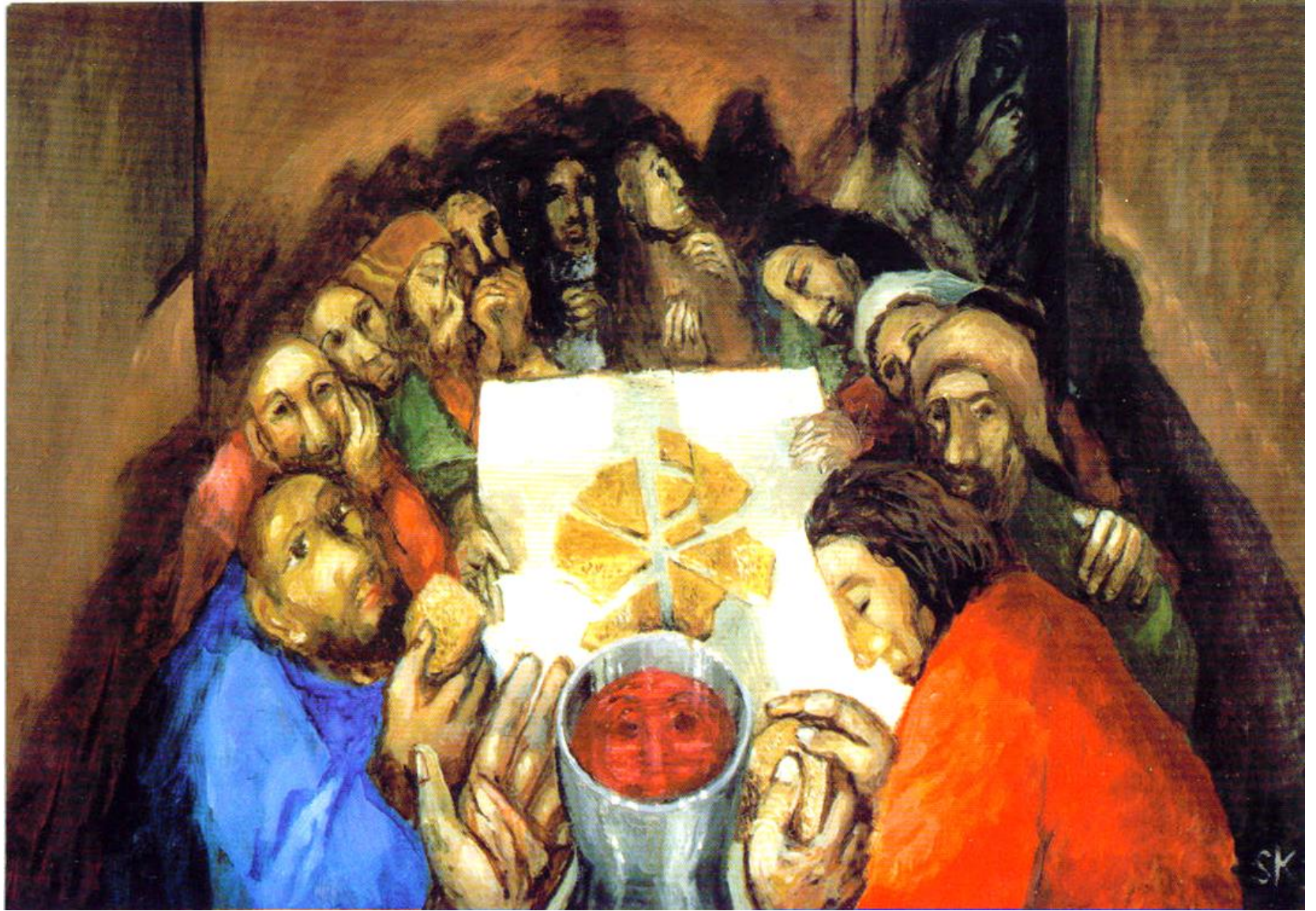

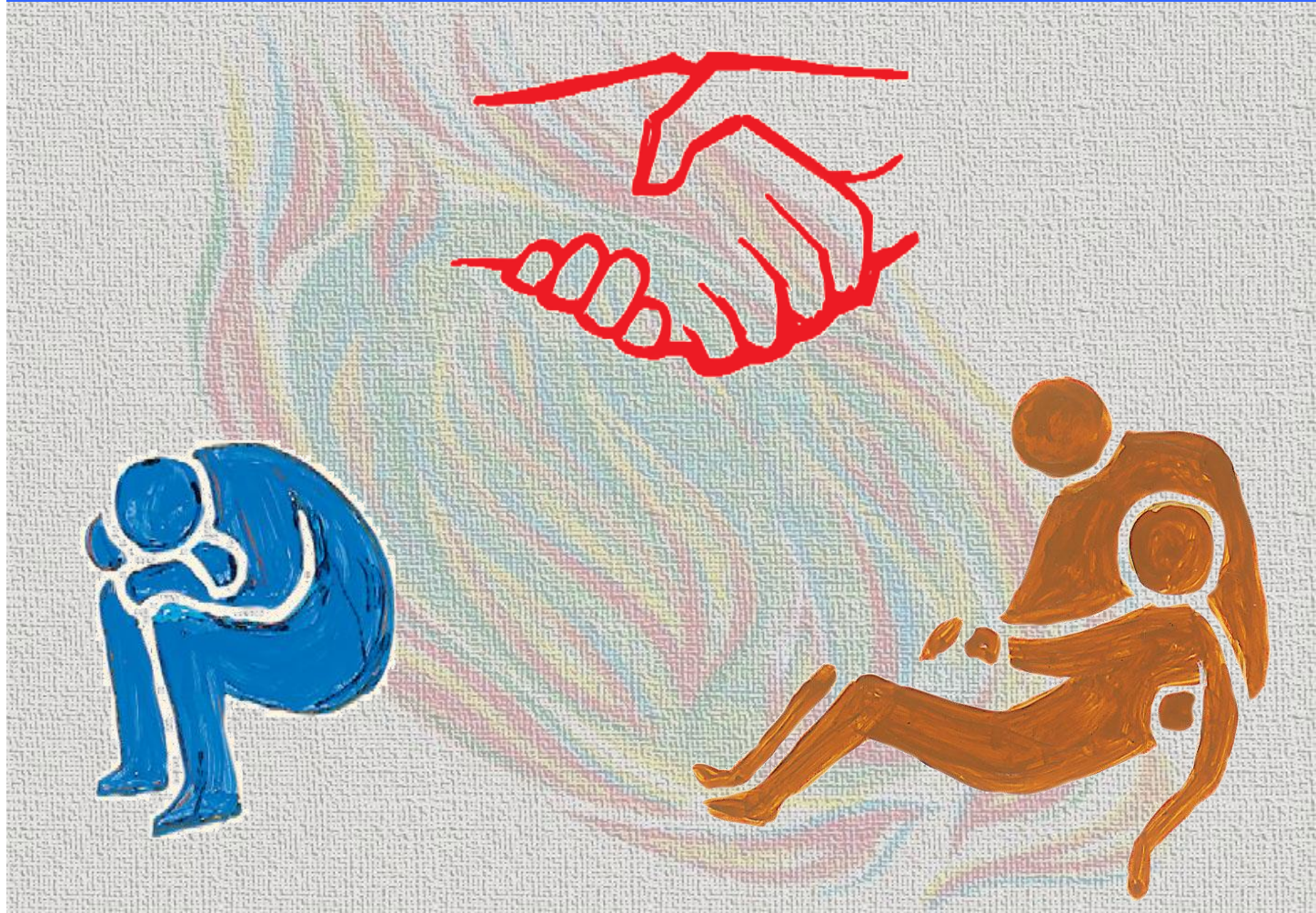

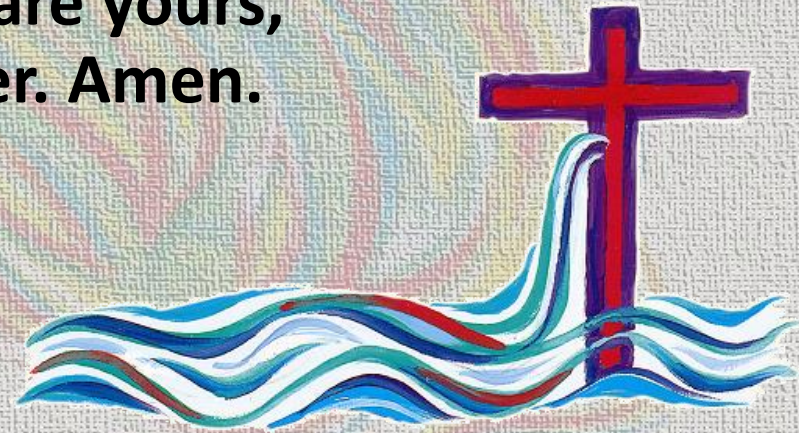

daily bread.**



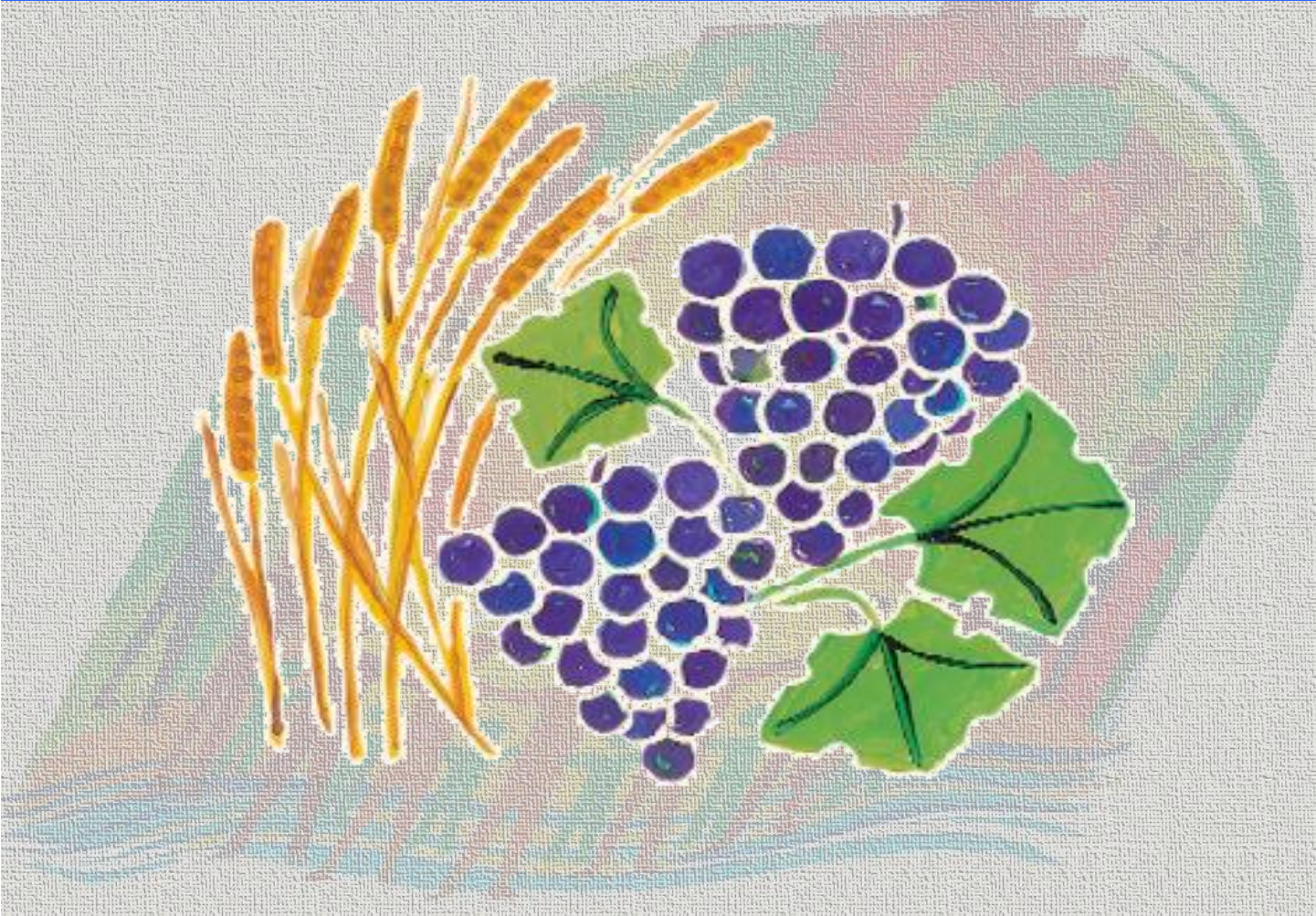
**Forgive us our sins

we praise your holy name.

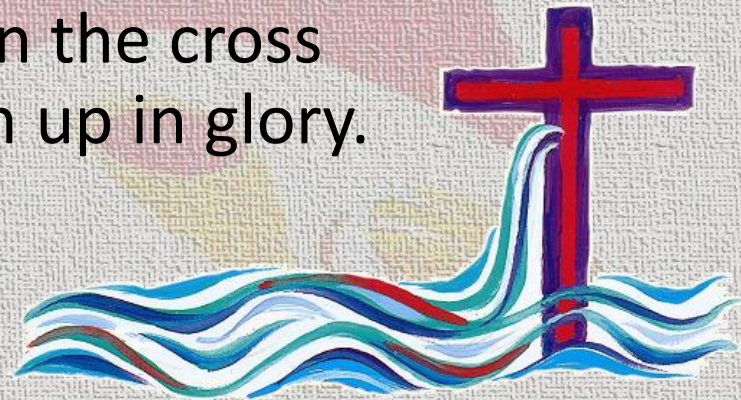
**Holy, holy, holy Lord,

The bread is broken

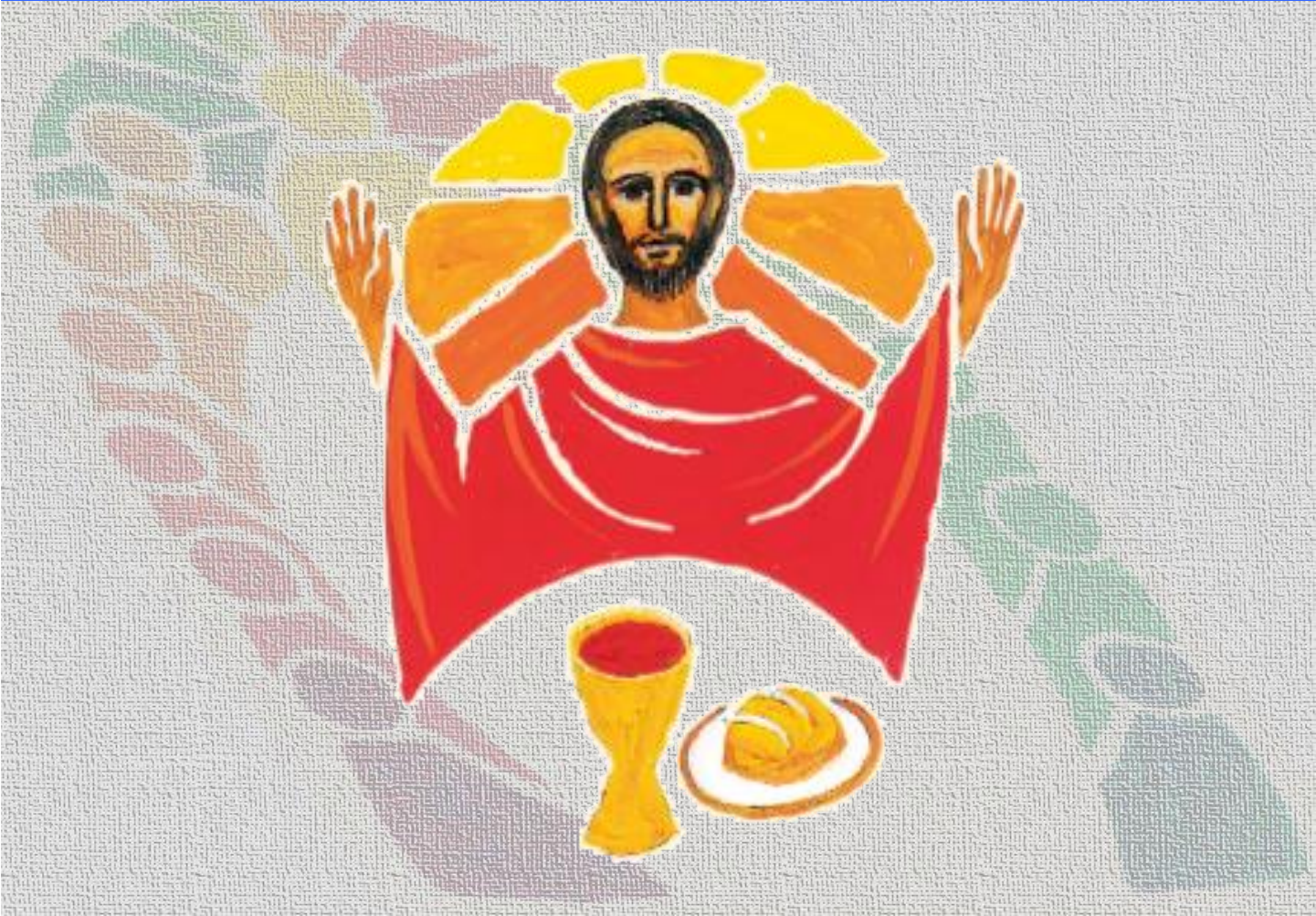
Jesus, Lamb of God,
