#### Aid for Persecuted Christians

During Lent I am following the Barnabas Aid prayer manual. Each day there is an article on an area of the world or special situation where Christians are being persecuted for their faith.

The prayer on 19th February was for Burkina Faso which is a country which was once a place of religious tolerance where its majority (60%) Muslim population lived in peace with Christians (30%) and followers of African traditional religions (10%).

However, extremist insurgents from Mali and Niger since 2015 has changed that and in recent weeks there was a murderous attack on a Catholic Church service when several people died.

Barnabas Aid provide support in various ways to Christians in these situations and we would like to invite you support this work with a special offering during our Easter services. There will be a separate plate available for your contributions on Easter morning.

#### Weekly Offering & Gift Aid

We do not ask visitors for money, however should you wish to give there is an offering bowl just inside the main doors to the church at each service. If you wish to give by standing order/onlinebanking, please ask the duty steward (wearing a purple lanyard) for details of the appropriate church bank account. (This type of payment helps us avoid banking costs incurred by paying in cash/cheques.)

If you pay income tax you can fill in a form which allows the church to claim back 25p for every £1 at no cost to yourself. These forms are available from the duty steward on a Sunday morning.

The amount claimed back in recent years has approached £10,000 pa and has often prevented expenditure exceeding income in the annual accounts.


