#### East Anglian Methodist Heritage Centre

The East Anglia Methodist Heritage Centre at Wighton (NR23 1PG), will have a special Easter weekend opening on **Saturday 30 March and Monday 1 April**, from 11 am to 3 pm each day. It is a treasure trove of Methodist history, explaining the development of the church over the past 200 years through artefacts, ceramics and pictures collected from across East Anglia. Find out about the impact of the Methodist people through exhibits on music, youth work, overseas missions and social action. For those keen to study more, there is a well-stocked Library and growing collection of historic documents linked to the churches of East Anglia, including special orders of service, press cuttings and photos.

After the Easter weekend, the Heritage Centre, housed in the former Primitive Methodist Church, will be open on Tuesdays and Fridays from 11 am to 3 pm and is free to visit. Visits at other times, or for groups, can be arranged on request (please call 07546 732 092). You are assured of a warm welcome from the team of volunteers. A toilet is available and there is parking alongside the chapel.

### Weekly Offering & Gift Aid

We do not ask visitors for money, however should you wish to give there is an offering bowl just inside the main doors to the church at each service. If you wish to give by standing order/onlinebanking, please ask the duty steward (wearing a purple lanyard) for details of the appropriate church bank account. (This type of payment helps us avoid banking costs incurred by paying in cash/cheques.)

If you pay income tax you can fill in a form which allows the church to claim back 25p for every £1 at no cost to yourself. These forms are available from the duty steward on a Sunday morning.

The amount claimed back in recent years has approached £10,000 pa and has often prevented expenditure exceeding income in the annual accounts.
