Weekly Offering & Gift Aid

We do not ask visitors for money, however should you wish to give there is an offering bowl just inside the main doors to the church at each service. If you wish to give by standing order/onlinebanking, please ask the duty steward (wearing a purple lanyard) for details of the appropriate church bank account. (This type of payment helps us avoid banking costs incurred by paying in cash/cheques.)

If you pay income tax you can fill in a form which allows the church to claim back 25p for every £1 at no cost to yourself. These forms are available from the duty steward on a Sunday morning.

The amount claimed back in recent years has approached £10,000 pa and has often prevented expenditure exceeding income in the annual accounts.

If you know anyone who could be interested, I am happy to arrange an in person visit or zoom call. Full or part time. Chaplains who are full time either work a Saturday if Catholic or Sunday if Anglican/Free Church and get paid 20% extra for doing so on top of the salary and the Alpha civil service

pension. Part timers also work Sundays or Saturdays but on a rota. Hours are 8 am to 4-5pm, with flexileave scheme and shorter hours on weekends.
