### Link to Hope Shoeboxes News

We received this from Vivian Sargeant from Clare Baptist Church: Good afternoon. A bit early, but wishing you a blessed Christmas I am thrilled to be able to tell you that we sent 793 boxes from Clare on the 10<sup>th</sup> November and £1700 towards transport costs. Every one of your contributions, goods, boxes, donations, time in bringing boxes to Clare and helping with the packing all made that possible.

By the 11<sup>th</sup> November with the help of wonderful volunteers at Ferrying warehouse, all our boxes had been checked and loaded onto pallets. The first lorry containing 6, 316 boxes left the warehouse with your boxes on them on the 18<sup>th</sup> November to a central warehouse in Romania. From there they will be distributed to the four countries.

You can also help without increasing your current giving: if you already have a standing order and pay tax to the Inland Revenue, you can sign the Gift Aid declaration, which will boost your donation by 25%. The Gift Aid Declaration form can be requested from any steward. The amount claimed back in recent years has approached £10,000 pa and has often prevented expenditure exceeding income in the annual accounts.


#### Highway 35 - Meeting disaster head-on with hope
