I have ordered the Methodist Prayer Handbook for the new Methodist year, starting in September. I have bought in bulk and have been able therefore to get them at a reduced price,  $\pounds4.15$  rather than  $\pounds4.50$ 

The general title for the Handbook this year is 'The Greatest Commandment.'

The handbook is a wonderful resource. It has 2 pages of prayers for each day of the month - one for Methodists in a different part of the world and one for a District in the British Methodist Connexion. (Last year our district (East Anglia) was on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of the month.) It is amazing to discover just how much the Methodist Church is doing worldwide.

The handbook also contains general pages of prayers and a pull-out section giving a reading, psalm and hymn suggestion for each day of the year.

<u>Threads Through Creation Exhibition</u>

Eight million stitches expressing God's love!

'Threads through Creation' is an extraordinary, uplifting textile art exhibition touring twenty cathedrals. It's touching thousands, and most people are blown away by it.

It's on at Bury St Edmunds - at St Edmundsbury Cathedral until 4th September. There is a document attached to this email to tell you more about it.

Go to St Eds, and you'll get to see a spectacular display of twelve huge and beautiful silk panels retelling the story of Creation from Genesis. You've probably read the story in black and white – now see a retelling in glorious colour!

It took Christian artist Jacqui Parkinson three years, miles of thread - and eight million stitches!

It's a great opportunity for Christians to enjoy, and one of those occasions where you can take non-Christian friends to – and be certain they'll enjoy it.

You can get some glimpses of all this on BBC TV Songs of Praise, this Sunday 7th August, 1.15pm and on BBC iPlayer after that.
