#### Sound System

We have had our current sound system for over twenty years and as I am sure many of you are aware it is no longer fit for purpose.

At our church council meeting last Wednesday it was unanimously agreed that the system should be replaced. The cost to replace it will be in the region of £20,000.00.

We have two legacies from Thelma Mills and Reta Crick totalling £17,000 and the Church Council agreed that using this money to purchase the new sound system would be a lasting legacy to both Thelma and Reta. We therefore need to raise a further £3,000.00

We understand that, given the current economic situation, we are currently all experiencing financial stress. However, if any of our members are in a position to make a gift or an interest free loan this will enable us to go ahead without putting undue stress on the Church finances.
