• Book of remembrance

On the church communion table is a book of remembrance of loved ones who have died.

The book is a yearly diary.

The names of loved ones are recorded on the relevant page, along with the year of their death.

Each Sunday, the book is opened to show the current day's date. The book needs updating.

If you or someone you know has calligraphy skills so that more names can be added now and in the future, please speak to Peter. Also, if you would like a name or names recorded in the book of remembrance please write down the name/s and date/s and give them to Peter. Thank you.

• Church Finances

A number of members of our congregation have commented on the fact that they are not sure how our church finances work. So, I thought it might be useful to give you a breakdown of our income and expenses.

Our Annual income is derived from three main Sources:

1. Monthly Standing orders and weekly collections	£52,500	66%
2. Renting out or premises	£15,750	20%
3. Tax refunds from Gift Aid	£ <u>11,000</u>	14%
Total Income	£ <u>79,250</u>	

From this we have to pay into our circuit funds:

Manse repairs	£1,000	1.75%

We also have to meet our church running costs which currently stand annually at £35,000

The current shortfall is being met from reserves.

• Some questions and answers for our church

What is changing?

Peter's appointment as church minister will soon be completed and he has been appointed to serve in the Jersey Circuit in the Channel Islands District.

Why is Peter moving on?

The Methodist ministry is a travelling ministry. Peter is moving on to his fifth Circuit appointment in twenty three years as a minister.

When will Peter move?

Peter's final Sunday morning service is on Sunday 16th July. He will take annual leave and then move sometime at the end of July or beginning of August and begin his new appointment on 1st September.

What about Peter's family?

With James and Sally now both adults, they are making decisions about their futures, which may or may not be in Jersey.

For certain, Peter and Jo will be making their home in Jersey and James and Sally are fully supportive of the move.

Who will be replacing Peter as church minister?

At the moment our vacancy has not been filled. This is due to a shortage of ministers and a lack of ministers willing to serve in East Anglia this year.

Will we be without a minister?

If the vacancy is not filled, an existing Superintendent from within the East Anglia District will be appointed as a 'Titular Superintendent' from September 1st

Superintendent' from September 1st.

This is something our church has experienced before, prior to Peter's appointment.

Conversations about a possible Titular Superintendent are already taking place, should one be required.

They would have oversight of our church, along with their existing responsibilities, so their contribution would look different from Peter's.

A Titular Superintendent would work closely with our Stewards to ensure continuity in good church order, good communication and good pastoral care.

Ministry cover for the period of July 17th to September 1st will also be arranged.

When will we have a new minister?

The Methodist Conference meets 22-29 June and finalises the appointments of ministers for September. If our vacancy is not filled, then the Titular Superintendent will be appointed.

We will then enter the 'stationing' process for finding a new minister, for appointments beginning in September 2024. There are no guarantees, but there will be a new selection of ministers on the move.

What about future Sunday Services?

We are blessed and thankful to have a team of preachers who will continue to lead our worship, complemented by visiting preachers.

A preaching plan for September to November will be put in place over the summer.

What can I do?

At this time of change and uncertainty we might experience feelings of sadness, worry, concern, confusion and more, for ourselves and our church.

This is natural and okay. Talking about it is important. Talk to others. If you have a question or concern, talk to Peter or one of our Stewards and they will be pleased to listen and respond.

And talk it over with God in prayer. Pray into this time of change. Pray together. Watch out for more church Prayer Meetings and attend if you can.

Going forward it will be important for us as a church to remain positive, to keep calm and carry on trusting, serving, worshipping and witnessing, just as we are now.

We need to stay in fellowship and unity with one another.

Take heart, things will change but much will remain the same. Continue coming to church. Your presence and contribution are important.

God is faithful and will see us through.
