### <u>Message from Peter – Change in restrictions from Monday</u> July 19th – How will it affect our church?

As we anticipate lifting of Coronavirus restrictions, like many churches we need to consider our response.

Instead of hard and fast rules, we now have to make our own informed decisions about protecting ourselves and others from a deadly virus that has not gone away.

We shall do this on an individual basis when we each decide 'Will I continue to wear a face covering when I shop?'.

When it comes to our church community, our individual choices need to yield to the needs of the whole church body.

We cannot cast off all restraint while the risk to health is still prevalent.

We may have new freedoms but we still have the same responsibility to one another, especially to the clinically vulnerable and those who have not yet received both doses of the vaccination. Once we have seen the full government guidance for places of worship after Monday 19th July, our church leadership will be in a position to make decisions about the next step.

The church stewards will discuss arrangements with myself next week and make decisions. Please pray for God's wisdom and guidance. Your safety is our priority.

The government has already indicated that the social distance rule of '1 metre plus' will be lifted.

I anticipate that our current system of booking seats for Sunday worship will no longer be in place on and after Sunday 25th July. I mention this now so you know not to book seats with Kathy next week.

(Seat booking is still required for this coming Sunday 18th July)

I will give an update in our next Connect on Friday 23rd July so that you will know what to expect.

We are thankful to God for advances being made and we put our trust in God for the future.

• <u>Sponsored Ride & Stride – Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> September 2021</u>

Suffolk Churches Ride and Stride sponsored bike ride/walk/scooter ride/horse ride takes place on Saturday 11 September 2021. Suffolk originated the idea of a Ride in 1982 and since then most of the country has taken up the fund raising idea.. Over 650 churches in Suffolk will be open and it is hoped to improve on the £180,000 raised last year.

Suffolk Historic Churches Trust is a non-denominational Trust helping preserve the county's historic churches and chapels and our chapel at Weston Colville has benefitted in the past.

Sponsorship income is shared equally between the Trust and the rider's nominated church.
