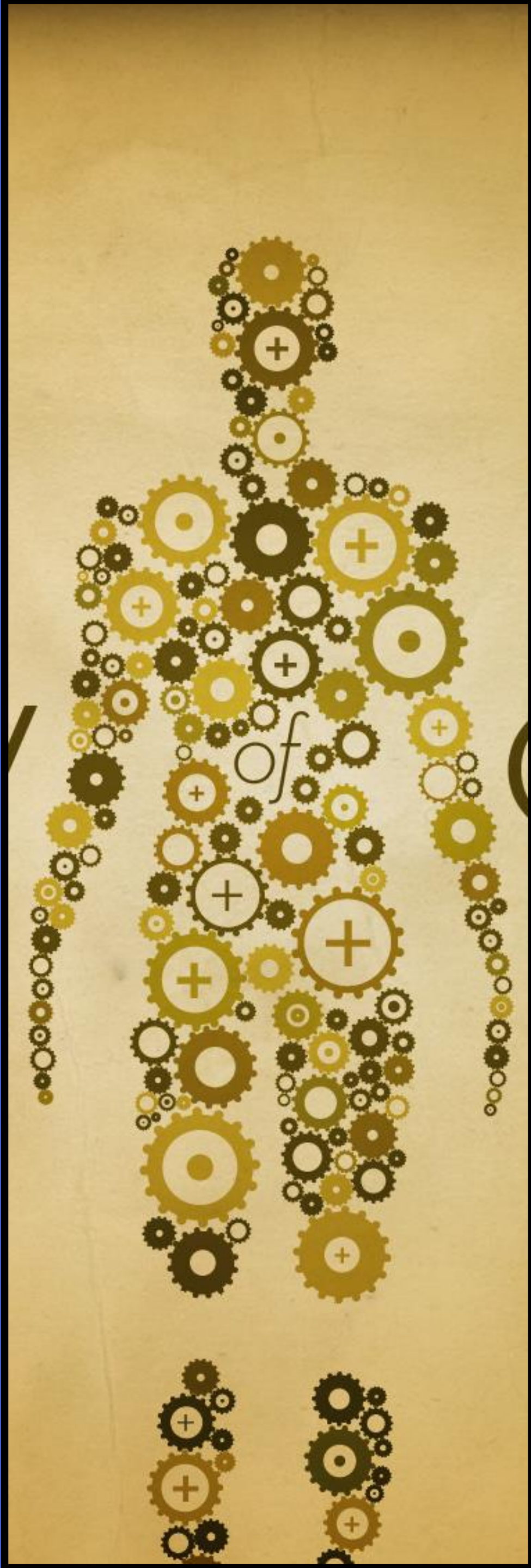

It is right to give our thanks and praise.




Jesus, Light of the World

let us worship you as you deserve.**


By your grace, meet us and minister to us,

Christ.**


**Forgive us, Lord,

of your eternal promises to us.




We say together the prayer that Jesus gave us:

Give us today our daily bread.**




**Forgive us our sins

now and for ever.**


Amen.
